Duration	One year - Applicants will need to reapply for subsequent years.
Intention of scholarship	Expenses directly related to the study of successful applicants (e.g. course costs, study related materials or equipment, textbooks).

Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To be eligible, the following criteria must be met: • Australian citizen or permanent resident, living in Yarrabilba (proof of address must be provided) • Studying full-time in 2023 in an approved Australian university or TAFE course • Demonstration of disadvantage hindering further study • Demonstration of commitment to academic achievement and community involvement
Nationality	Grants will be awarded on the recommendation of the Yarrabilba Community Grants Program Advisory Board and will be assessed on how well project outcomes align with Lendlease's social, economic and environmental priority areas. Applications that demonstrate collaboration with other Yarrabilba organisations, groups, schools, or clubs will be highly regarded.
