

ATHRESTONE DISPLAY VILLAGE COMPETITION – VISIT STAMP & WIN – TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The Promoter is Lendlease Communities (Atherstone) Pty Limited ABN 16 110 348 108 of Level 14, Tower Three, International Towers Sydney, Exchange Place, 300 Barangaroo Avenue, Barangaroo, NSW, Sydney 2000. Contact number is 1300 739 839.
 2. Only residents of Australia aged 18 of age or older (Participant) are eligible for the Competition.
 2. The following person(s) are ineligible to enter the Competition:
 - a) employees of:
 - I. the Promoter; and
 - II. the Promoter's related bodies corporate (as that expression is defined in the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth)) and associated agencies, companies and contractors; or
 - b) members of the Immediate Families of the employees referred to at paragraph 3(a).
- Immediate family** means any of: a spouse or domestic partner, ex-spouse or ex-domestic partner, de-facto spouse or ex-de-facto spouse, child or step child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step parent, grandparent, step grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step brother, step sister or first cousin.

 4. To enter you must visit the Atherstone Sales & Information centre and pick up the Visit, Stamp & Win passport. During Competition Period, you must visit the display homes of at least three different builders in the Atherstone Display Village, collecting stamps in your passport from each home visited. In addition, you must name your favourite home design and why and record your answer in the passport. Once complete, you need to drop the passport back to the Atherstone Sales Centre before the end of the Competition Period to be eligible to enter the draw. Only one entry per person will be accepted.
 5. For the Participant to be eligible to compete in the Competition, each of the following must be satisfied. The Participant must enter the Competition:
 - a) within the Competition Period;
 - b) in the strict manner specified on the entry form for the Competition; and
