Growing a greener future

Year 9 students from San Damiano College have helped cultivate a sustainable community here in Yarrabilba, planting 85 native seedlings for the "Connecting Communities Program."

The students, who have previously been learning about the carbon cycle in the classroom, went out on the school grounds to dig deep, planting their own natives alongside Natura Pacific and Lendlease. The group were further educated by the team from Natura on climate change, the carbon cycle and the role of native plants in carbon sequestration.

Open for play! Let's explore Yarrabilba's newest community park



Celebrating its deep connection to Country and the cultural stories of the Aboriginal People, Yarrabilba's newest community park, Borrol Lookout, is now officially open for the whole community to enjoy.

RPS Group Principal Landscape Architect Emma Fraser takes us on a tour of the new playscape, which will support community connection, encourage children to learn about the park's cultural significance, all while embracing the natural surroundings.

"The vision for the park is to share Country with the community through retelling the Yugambeh story of Bingingerra. The design retains the existing vegetation, protects the rock face, and celebrate the view to the mountains," she said.

"This park is located on the highest point in Yarrabilba. It sits on a rocky outcrop referred to as South Rock, and has an expansive view of the mountains to the south which are central to the story telling. A number of Indigenous artefacts have been found here".

Jabree, the cultural heritage body for Yarrabilba, has collaborated with Lendlease and RPS Group to outline cultural stories and help incorporate the local culture within the Yarrabilba development. From this collaboration, two key stories have been explored in this park, the nearby Bora Ring and the creation of Mount Witheren – Bingingerra.



South Rock adventurers learning the Bingingerra story at Yarrabilba

South Rock State School recently celebrated the opening of Borrol Lookout Park in Yarrabilba with 100 Foundation students and staff.

The park features a significant rocky outcrop called South Rock, offering the highest vantage point in Yarrabilba. It also provides views of Mt Tamborine, Mt Witheren, and Canungra, celebrating the southern vista. The park's design incorporates the story of 'Bingingerra,' a giant freshwater turtle who transformed into Mt Bingingerra (Mt Witheren) after a battle between land and sea animals.

RPS and Eureka Landscapes paid careful attention to incorporating these elements into the park's design, including carvings and a lookout that offers views of the surrounding mountain ranges. Jabree Ltd played a crucial role in understanding the park's cultural significance. Students from South Rock State School, from Prep to Year 6, enjoyed learning about the Bingingerra story through the park's features, including interpretive signage, carvings, and a playground. They also participated in an art workshop with Quandamooka Artist Libby Harward, focusing on the story's animals, and an interactive session with Cultural Educator Rick Roser that included ochre, feathers and clap sticks.













Hearing Children's Voices


At South Rock State School their vision is 'Building pride, belonging to our community'.

The school wants students and families to become part of the school community right from the beginning of their involvement, and have developed the Hearing Children's Voices – Our Transition Project. By giving students and families the opportunity to share their thoughts on the transition from Kindy to Prep, the school can develop the transition program they want and need and ensure positive relationships are developed before the students even commence at school.

The project will be conducted throughout Term 3 with support from the local Early Childhood Education Centres the children attend Kindy, or the families themselves. The project will entail opportunities for the future student to share their thoughts in a secure online environment by sharing drawings, videos and audio responses. Families will also receive brief surveys to share their thoughts.

Career pathways and local business support in Yarrabilba



The Exchange is a one stop shop supporting local jobs, skilling, and enterprise in Yarrabilba. As an initiative of Lendlease, this service is free of charge to both Yarrabilba residents of working age and employers. Since its inception in December 2016, over 3,510 locals have been supported by The Exchange, with over 1,258 jobseekers placed into local employment and over 432 into skilling and training. We couldn't achieve this without the support of a wide range of stakeholder partners who are equally as committed to helping the Yarrabilba community thrive.

Our newest community hub - The Buzz at Yarrabilba - is a central meeting place that supports community connection, learning, earning and innovation. So, it makes sense that The Exchange has made its new home here to best serve local residents. The community hub is managed by the YMCA, and The Y's new manager of The Exchange service, Mr Niu Fiu, has been super busy over the past few months, making lots of new connections and expanding the services to continue meeting the needs of our growing community.

"The Exchange is here to empower Yarrabilba's residents to take control of their career journey, providing support and guidance to connect them to local job opportunities and help them thrive in the workforce. This even includes the early building blocks for young people considering their future careers. We are here to facilitate better connections between job seeker individuals with employers in the local area, ensure training is delivered locally and is tailored to specific vacancies in a wider range of industries including hospitality, construction, business, aged care and disability. The Exchange is also a resource that Yarrabilba's Small Businesses and Home Based Businesses can tap into for guidance and support, whether they are established or just starting out" said

The Exchange also collaborates with partner schools to deliver school to work transition strategies and opportunities, provide assistance identifying local work experience and volunteering opportunities, facilitate access to accredited training courses to existing employers and candidates to assist the pathway to sustainable employment. Access to accredited training will be given a huge boost now that Yarrabilba will have its own TAFE based at The Buzz.

Just in the last few months The Exchange has been supporting locals in the following initiatives:

- Apprenticeship program by Australian Training Company with YSSC Yr 11 students
- Ready 4 Employment pathway opportunities with resume writing and cover letter assistance
- Registering students into traineeships, work experience and volunteering opportunities
- Supported QLD Small Business Month with informative workshops & networking for local small and home based businesses
- Collaborated with Reclink in supporting participants with graduation and ongoing employment opportunities
- Played host to Lendlease's recently revived Meet Your Neighbours events as they made a post-covid return to community hubs
