Development update

Six Mile Creek Corridor Rehabilitation

The balance of the rehabilitation of the Six Mile Creek corridor has been split into two sections, with the first phase between The Corso and Regents Drive now nearing completion.

Specialised engineering was applied to address an area subject to significant erosion during storms, with the channel being reprofiled adjacent to Heron Park to remove the unsightly level changes and steep batters.

The final section of rehabilitation extending south from Regents Drive to the boundary of Fernbrooke Ridge will commence this month, with completion by the end of the year. These works are being undertaken in co-ordination with Ipswich City Council's environmental team.

Pedestrian Bridge

Installation of the 20m span pedestrian bridge across Six Mile Creek occurred on 1 September and construction of the approach ramps and footpaths will be completed shortly. This piece of infrastructure will connect The Corso to Walter Williams Crescent, improving connectivity for residents and opening up new options for exercise 'circuits'.

Redbank Plains Distributor Road

The extension of Mount Juillerat Drive from School Road up to the junction with Regents Drive will be completed this month and following Council approval, will then be opened to the public.

Heron Park

Some improvements are about to commence in Heron Park including replacement of the shade canopy and setting the river pebbles in concrete in the rock swale to secure them. Once these works are completed Council will assume responsibility for the park.
